

Marshall Bridge Preserve

Rules and Regulations

Marshall Bridge Preserve is owned and managed by The Land Conservancy for Southern Chester County, a non-profit organization. We ask that you respect our neighbors and the wildlife that inhabit the preserve by following these guidelines:

- Visitation permitted year-round from DAWN TO DUSK.
- Park only in designated parking spaces. “No parking” means NO PARKING.
No double parking. Please return later if lot is full.
- WALK ON DESIGNATED TRAILS ONLY.
- DO NOT TRESPASS onto adjacent properties.
- ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES. No exceptions.
- PICK UP AFTER YOUR PET.
- PACK OUT ALL TRASH brought to the preserve.
- DO NOT remove any plants, animals, rocks, or artifacts from the preserve.
THIS IS THEFT and violators will be prosecuted.
- Horseback riding is permitted on designated trails under dry conditions.
Please ride to and from the preserve. NO HORSE TRAILERS PERMITTED.
- NO UNAUTHORIZED MOTORIZED VEHICLES.
- NO UNAUTHORIZED DRONE USE.
- NO ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, DRUGS, OR FIRES.
- NO CAMPING, HUNTING, FISHING, OR LOITERING.
